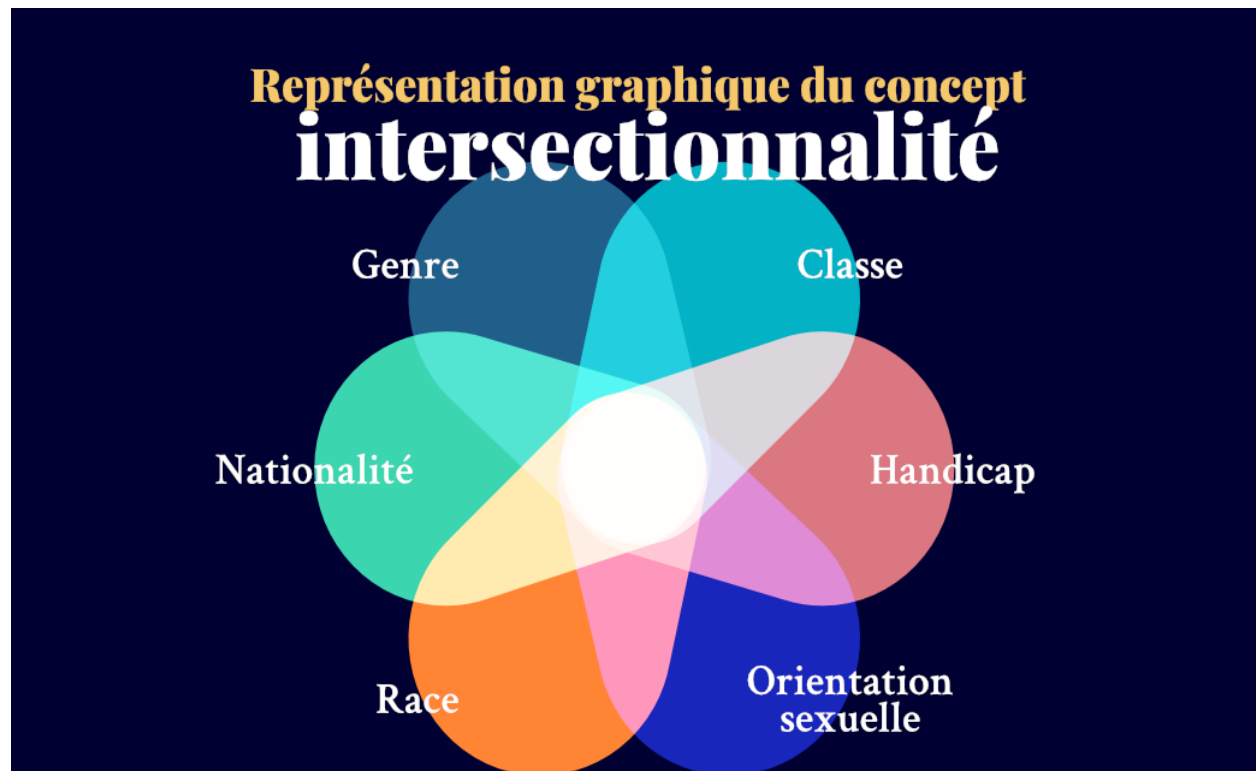


Forms of discrimination
