What was the ask?

- Create a modified 'Ready For School' Program for the Yazidi community
 - Long running JIAS program that prepares newcomer students to enter the Ontario school system
- Do it online
 - Without an existing framework
- Do it fast
 - Approximately 6 weeks from conception to class start



Biggest Challenges?

- Curriculum
- Assessment
- Staffing – Teachers / Art Therapist / Others
- Technology



Challenge - Curriculum

- Theme that works from Grade 1 through Grade 9
 - Canada / GTA
- Provides support for vulnerable population
 - Trauma informed programming
- Assist students to make academic progress
 - Parents report 80% of students have learning issues
- Is technology friendly
- Engages students – includes virtual field trips



Challenge - Assessment

- Created basic literacy assessment
 - Allocated 20 minutes per student
 - Planned to use Zoom on school supplied computers
 - *Surprised at lack of literacy despite 2+ years in Ontario schools*
- ➔ WhatsApp – 5 minute assessments



Challenge - Staffing

- Approx 50 students enrolled
 - Plan was for less than 20 students
- Ontario Certified Teachers and Ontario Certified English Language Teachers
 - Target max 7 students per teacher
- Art Therapist
- Field Trips –
 - Videos – Canada and the GTA,
 - Ripley's Aquarium and an Indigenous Drumming Circle



Challenge - Technology

- Curriculum / Assessment / Staffing
- What is the platform?
 - Zoom
- What does it run on?
 - Amazon Fire tablets
- Training



What did we do?

- 7 classes → 3 levels
 - Can't read – doesn't know alphabet
 - Can read basic words
 - Can read – might be able to write
- 3 days a week for 4 weeks
- Integrated with Project Abraham (other 2 days)
- Regular Staff Meetings and Training
- WhatsApp for communication / support



What's Next?

- Yazidi Literacy Tutoring Program
 - Many of the same students
 - Focus is on reading
 - Through Zoom
 - Volunteer Tutors (not teachers)
 - Training for the tutors



Accomplishments



- Created an online summer program to support school readiness
- Adapted to the challenges of curriculum, assessment and staffing. Used technology to overcome the pandemic imposed challenges.
- Learned about the educational needs of the community.
- Created a template the can be used in other communities.
- Learned that the keys are **FLEXIBILITY** and **ADAPTABILITY**
- Set up a follow-up program.
