AHS has recently translated several COVID-19 resources to make them available in Arabic, Simplified Chinese, Traditional Chinese, French, Punjabi, Spanish, Tigrinya, and Vietnamese. Somali translations will be available in the coming days. Each of these languages will have a dedicated COVID-19 page with resources, including:

- Frequently asked questions for the public
- Posters which provide information on visiting a hospital, emergency department and continuing care facility, how to care for a patient with COVID-19, and other topics
- A video promoting physical distancing


# CLIP: Emerging priorities
