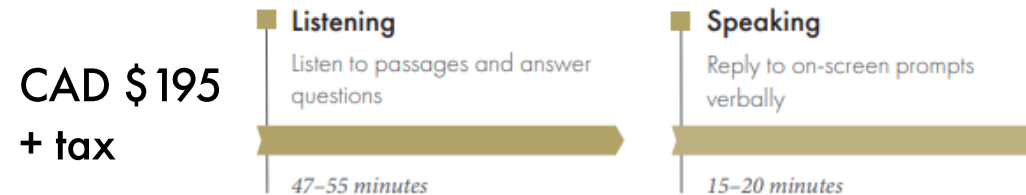
CELPIP- General Test Format (for IRCC permanent and temporary residency programs)

CELPIP-General total test time is under 3 hours, and is done in one sitting. Test price is CAD \$290 + tax. International test fees may vary.



CELPIP- General LS Test Format (for Canadian citizenship applications)

CELPIP-General LS total test time is about 1 hour 10 minutes, and is done in one sitting. Test price is \$195 CAD + tax.

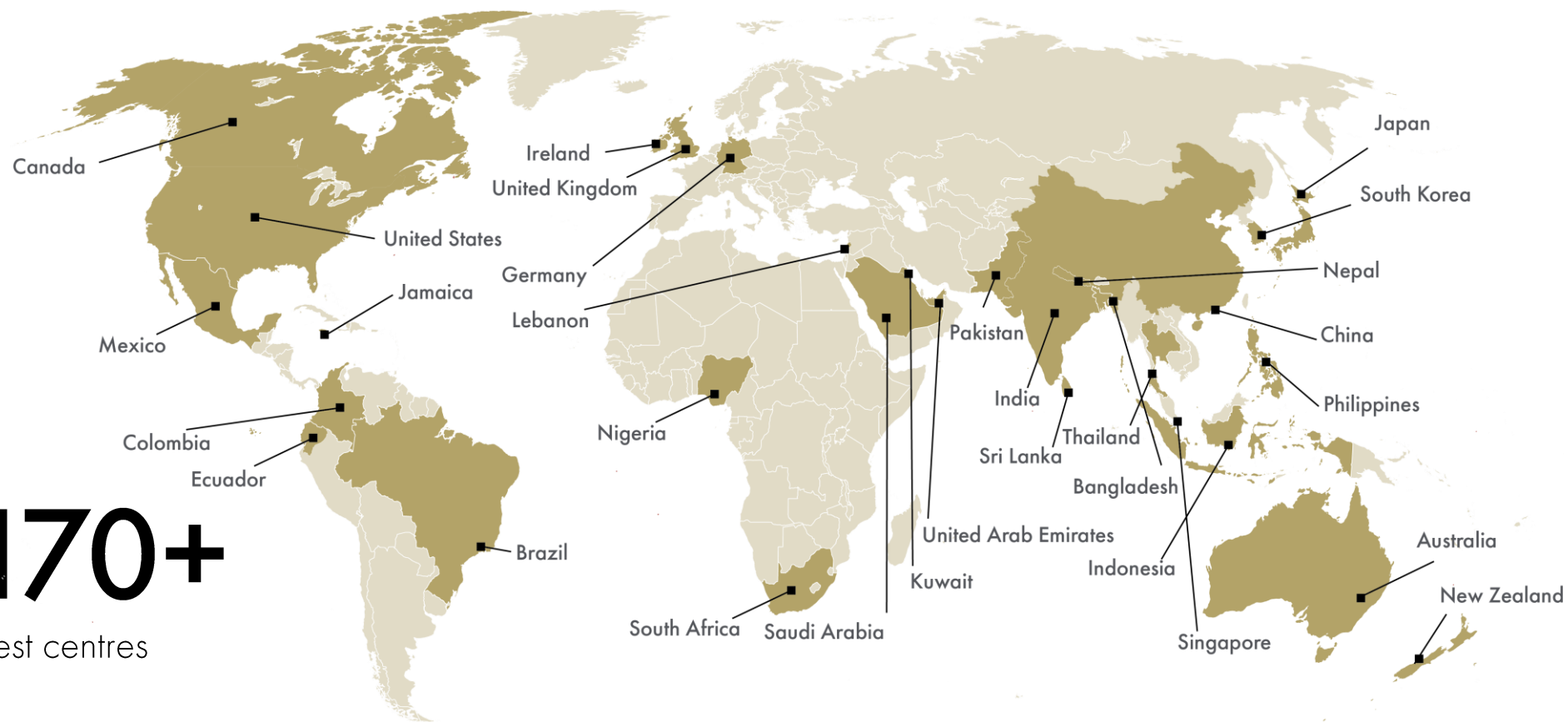

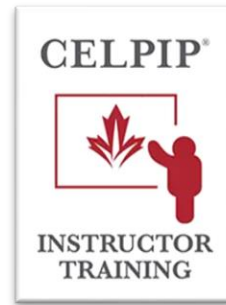

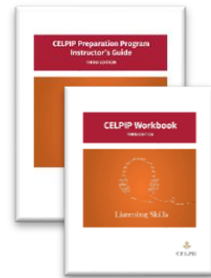

CELPIP – Horizon is a 55-minute four-part exam that can be taken anywhere via Prometric's remote assessment platform, ProProctor.

Designed to evaluate the four fundamental aspects of the English language to accurately gauge your candidate's English proficiency. With this exam, we can verify the skills and competency of applicants, providing you with the validation needed to qualify the right candidate within a timely and accurate manner. The goal of CELPIP – Horizon is to qualify candidates for different programs or jobs.

Test Sections

CELPiP – Horizon is comprised of 4 sections:



Reading

Eleven questions about a written passage

- Multiple choice (6 questions)
- Select from a list (5 questions)



Writing

Write a response based off a prompt
(1 question)



Listening

Eleven questions about recorded audio

- Identifying similar meaning (3 questions)
- Answering short answers (3 questions)
- Listening to a news item (5 questions)



Speaking

Record an answer based off a question
(3 questions)

Use Cases

- YMCA of Southern New Brunswick and ImmigrateNow (a Metro Canadian Immigration Consulting Service)
 - Their goals are to use CELPIP Horizon for employment purposes. The idea is for the candidate to go through their programs and take the Horizon exam at the end to assess their English proficiency before entering the job market.
 - Candidates will also have access to their score report making it easy for them to share their scores with potential employers. "Here's my resume and here's my Horizon score"
 - They may also have their candidates sit for the exam when they first start the program in order to see what their candidates need to improve on.

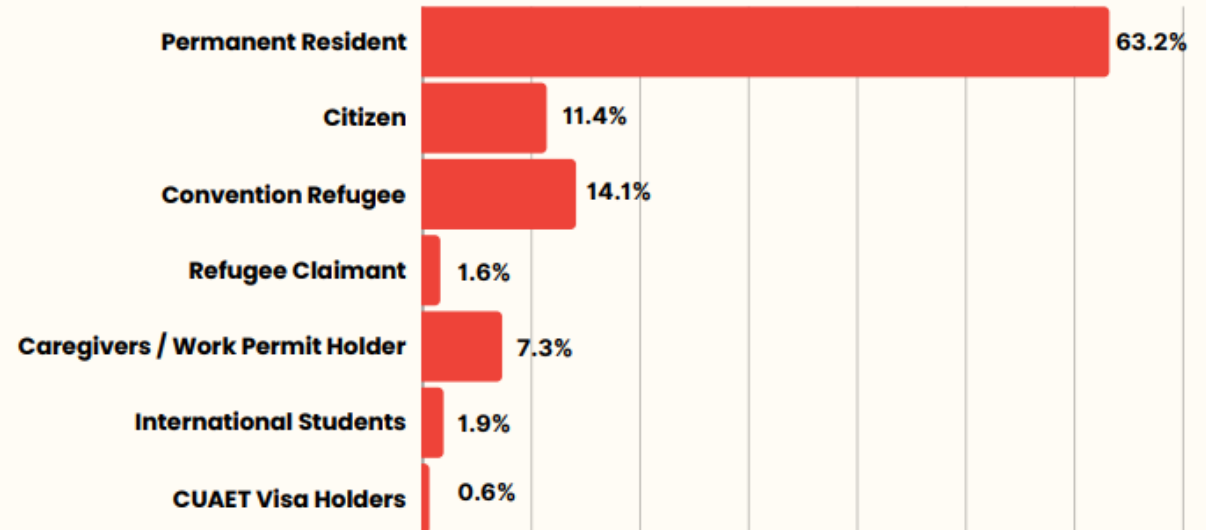

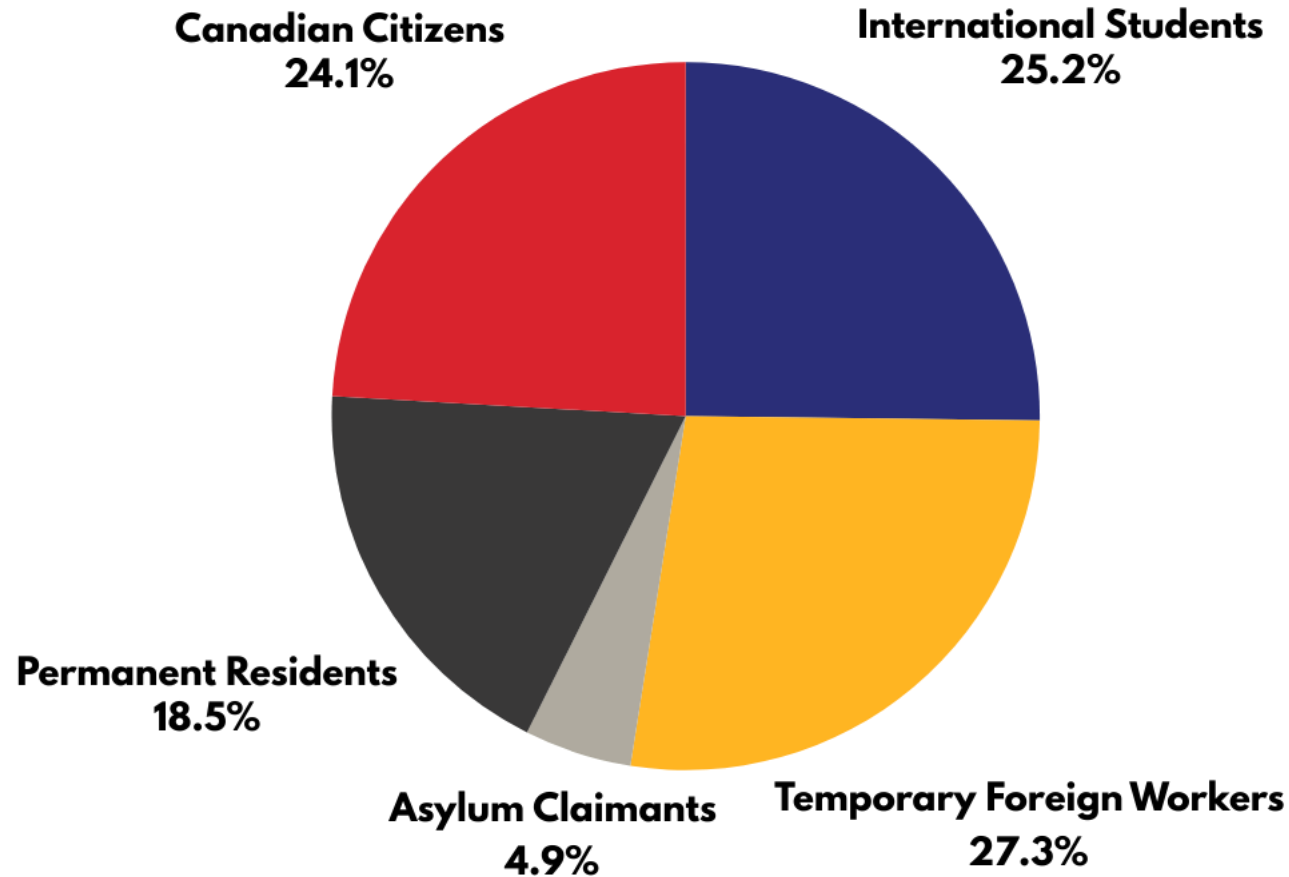

CLIENT CHALLENGES



Affordable Housing

Many clients face significant barriers to finding safe and affordable housing due to rising costs and limited availability.



Employment Barriers

Unemployment is a major issue, as clients struggle to secure jobs that match their skills or provide sustainable income.



Mental Health

Increasing numbers of clients report distress or anxiety, particularly due to challenges such as navigating restrictive policies, uncertainty regarding their immigration status, and adapting in Canada.



Language Barriers

Clients often require support with language barriers, including assistance in interpreting government forms and improving proficiency to meet requirements for employment, citizenship, or immigration-related programs.

Interested in improving your English or French? The **Language Assessment and Referral Centre** at the YMCA of Greater Toronto offers free English and French language assessments to immigrants to Canada.

The assessments are based on the Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLBs) (PDF) and the Niveaux de Compétence Linguistique Canadiens (BTC-NLCL), the nationally recognized standard that measures speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Besides language assessment, the YMCA of GTA also refers you to government-funded English and/or French programs offered by community partners. Watch the video to learn more.





How has the program enhanced your confidence in communicating in French in social settings as well as in job interviews or at the workplace?

Before starting with CLIC Adapté, I was learning it myself on an app, because my parents were in France, and I wanted to be able to talk to my siblings in a different language. But I thought I was just a beginner, and I wouldn't even admit to anybody that was learning French.

But when I took the test here, I was assigned to the third level and I was told that I was better than most beginners. During the course, my writing skills improved, my speaking skills improved, and I feel more confident to say now in public that I know French. I was once able to guide somebody to a bus stop, in French.

Besides improving your language proficiency, how did the program contribute to your sense of belonging to the local community?

I didn't know after I arrived in Canada that one needs to get their degree evaluated to be able to get into higher education here. My teacher from CLIC Adapté had degrees from Germany and France herself so she guided me with my application and reassured me that even if it took time, I would eventually get there.


