 - 8- week with asynchronous coursework & online evening classes 2X a week
 - Patient centered communication skills with simulated patients
 - Feedback from profession language instructors
 - Minimum CLB 6/6/6/6
 - **Exploring AI (Cyberpatient) for simulated patient environment


National Healthcare Language Program

 - For Internationally Educated Nurses
 - 8 weeks of asynchronous coursework
 - Focus on speaking and listening to patients
 - Improve communication skills for workplace
 - Minimum CLB 6/6/6/6
 - **Piloting use of AI –Cyberpatient for nurses to practice
 Speaking skills in a life-like setting.

- Professional Communication Skills for Nurses (PCSN)
 - For Internationally Educated Nurses
 - Improves strategies to help pass CELBAN
 - Improve communication skills for workplace
 - 4 Modules
 - Speaking CLB 7+ | Asynchronous | 16 weeks | Online classes 2X week
 - Reading CLB 7+| Asynchronous | 10 weeks
 - Listening CLB 7+ | Asynchronous | 16 weeks
 - Writing CLB 6+ | Asynchronous | 10 weeks

- **2 classes high and low level

Outreach Program

- One-on-one instruction at home for literacy to CLB 4 clients
- Mothers, seniors or vulnerable clients with healthcare/mobility issues
- Versatile and specific in what we teach
- Outing in the community

Bi-Literacy and Program

- First Language literacy instruction
- Uni- or multilingual EAL foundational literacy classes
- Literacy concepts in the learner's first language.
- Classes are led by EAL instructor with instructional assistants





Accessibility Support Program (ASP)

Offers a tiered model of support for both literacy and mainstream clients:

- Tier 1:
 - Offer ISANS PD Sessions
 - Develop UDL resources and curriculum
 - Maintain multi-sensory lending library
- Tier 2:
 - Fully integrated clients with barriers in the classroom
- Tier 3:
 - One-on-support for a set period with goal of community integration or sheltered employment
