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BACKGROUND

- ➤ Canada relies on immigration for population and economic growth.
 - Declining Birthrate
 - Aging Population

Shrinking Labor Force


Attracting, Integrating and Retaining high-skilled immigrants is a top priority.

Successful integration and retention may depend largely on their acculturation experience

WHAT IS ACCULTURATION

Acculturation is the process of **psychological and behavioral changes** that occur **when** individuals or groups come into **contact** with **different cultures** (Berry, 2005).

Conceptual framework of acculturation



- ➤ Integration orientation in language domain (i.e., maintaining heritage as well as engaging with mainstream language) is ideal for Adaptation
 - Psychological Adaptation Feelings of well-being and life satisfaction
 - Socio-cultural Adaptation Ability to function and fit in with norms and practices of a new environment.

THE PROBLEM

▶72.5% of immigrants in Canada have a mother tongue other than English or French (i.e., a non-official language) (Statistics Canada, 2017).

- Language barriers and communication difficulties can lead to acculturative stress (Lou & Noels, 2020).


 - ➤ ↓ Mainstream language engagement ↓ Acculturation outcomes

➤ How can we intervene to make the conditions more favorable for positive acculturation and outcomes?

THE ROLE OF MINDSETS

Mindset: A person's way of thinking and assumptions that shape their perception, understanding, and response to the world around them..

The Synergistic Mindsets (Yeagar et., al, 2022)



THE SYNERGISTIC LANGUAGE MINDSET

Growth Language Mindset

- Language proficiency can be developed and achieved through consistent effort and engagement
- ➤ Understanding that helps you see struggles as a path to improvement (not a sign of inability)

Language Stress-can-beenhancing Mindset


- Stress responses from language related stress can be useful for enhancing performance
- ➤ Understanding that allows you to harness your stress response and use to develop your language proficiency.

METHODOLOGY

- Aim: To examine the effect of a Synergistic Language Mindset on ESL immigrant students' retention in Canada via its influence on language anxiety, language engagement, and adaptation.
- Study Design | Data Analysis : Cross-sectional Correlational Design | Path Analysis (Serial Mediation)
- Measures: Self-report Standardized Scales in a survey
- Participants: 114 ESL (English as Second/Additional Language) immigrant students from a University in BC. NB: *(data collection still ongoing)

PRELIMINARY FINDINGS | IMPLICATIONS

Path Model Results



Note. Significant standardized coefficients were reported. Dash lines indicated nonsignificant relations. * p < .05. ** p < .01. *** p < .001.

➤ Key Findings: The synergistic language mindset decreases language anxiety, which boosts language engagement, leading to better adaptation, which in turn predicts a stronger intention to stay in Canada (retention).

Implication: The insights support the development of interventions based on the principles of synergistic language mindsets to facilitate language acculturation, integration, and retention of ESL immigrants (especially high-skilled) in Canada.
