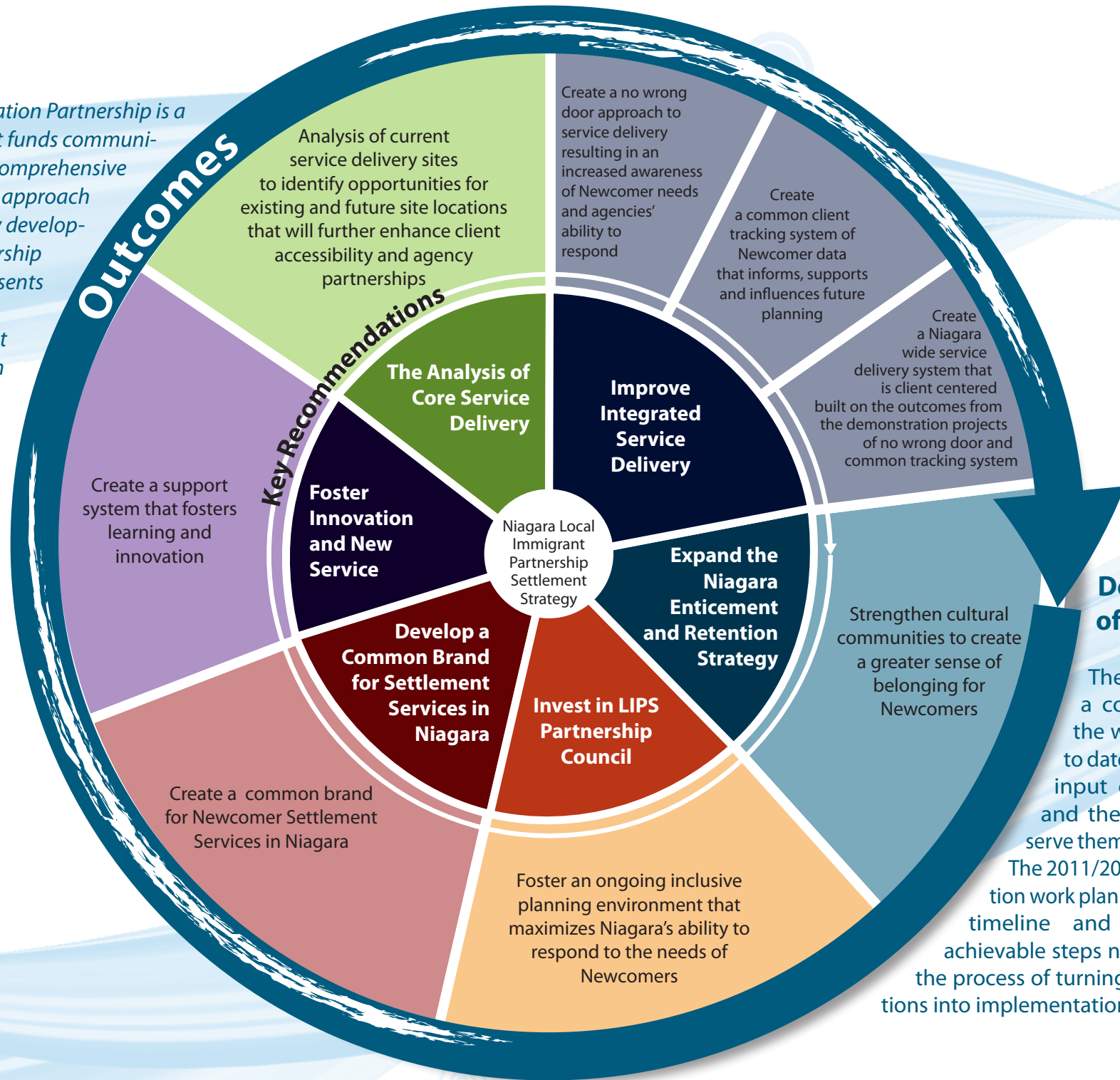

Mandate

Development of a Work Plan

The work plan is a compendium of the work completed to date with collective input of Newcomers and the agencies that serve them on a daily basis. The 2011/2012 implementation work plan outline includes timeline and measurable, achievable steps needed to begin the process of turning recommendations into implementation.
